Staying Safe

As COVID-19 restrictions ease and onsite appointments increase, we're taking precautions to keep you and our people safe.

What you can expect



Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) may be worn by our team, such as masks, gloves, and face shields. This is for your safety and ours



Physical distancing in place



Surfaces cleaned regularly



Temperature checks upon arrival



Limits to people in waiting areas. You may need to wait in your car or outside prior to an appointment



A sign in sheet, to screen for COVID-19 symptoms



Limits to people in appointments — one adult can accompany one child or adult. Unless critical, siblings cannot attend appointments or sites
